

## What is the novel Coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2)?

The first reported cases occurred among persons that had visited a wet market in Wuhan, China.

An outbreak of a new coronavirus is currently ongoing in China.

## What are the symptoms?

The virus can cause symptoms such as cough, fever and shortness of breath.



### Recommendations for travelers coming from areas with local or community transmission of Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2

If you recently returned from areas with presumed community transmission, and develop fever, cough or have difficulty breathing, within **14 days** since your return:

1. Stay home, travelers with symptoms of acute respiratory infection should maintain distance.
2. Call emergency first aid service (112) and let them know of your symptoms and travel history.
3. Wash your hands with soap and water, cover their mouth and nose with a tissue or a sleeve when coughing or sneezing.



### Recommendations for travelers going to areas with local or community transmission of Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2



Avoid contact with sick people, in particular those with a cough.



Wash your hands with soap and water.



Avoid contact with animals, their excretions or droppings.



Avoid visiting markets and places where live or dead animals are handled.
